As residents of we would like to comment on our concerns with the proposed work planned for the A55 at Dwygyfylchi.

We feel this would have a great impact on where we live; we also made it clear during a visit from Mike Gilbert & James Healey during September 2019 of our concerns and that we would like to be kept updated with any other developments, But we only received notice of the proposed plans as have all residents living in 100 meters of the scheme and feel we should of been prioritised due to the location of our property.

We did object to the choice of the new road layout back in 2019, as we think this layout had the biggest impact on the residents who are living nearest to this road, especially the extra traffic which will be passing.

As this now isn't going change and we are sure your decision to go ahead with this has already been made we are therefore now enquiring about what help and support there will be for residents like ourselves that are going to be directly effected during the 2 year construction? As we live adjacent and in very close proximity of the new road.
