Rob/Jen: viewed the Deposit Documents room this morning at Maen Alaw.

The queries that were raised are as follows:

1) Access to the beach during construction via the iron bridge adjacent to the Puffin Cafe. This was also raised by the Penmaenmawr Town Clerk Martin Hanks.

During the proposed building of the works, will access to the beach from Dwygyfylchi footpaths and Maes y Lan be available at all times during the construction work. If there is to be a closure and access denied why, for how long and when?

2) It was noted from the Environmental Masterplan drawings there looks like some form of fencing to stop sheep trespassing onto the link road/A55 but not defined in the Legend (We couldn't find it). Could you clarify what fencing is to be provided in this area. A sketch highlighting the fencing proposals including the bunding.

3) They also mentioned it would be a good idea to have a further crossing from Penmaenmawr Road across the A55 to link up with the cycleway NCNR5, just west of the current roundabout. This being part of improving connectivity to the beach area as occasionally the underpass under the railway near the cafe at Penmaenmawr gets flooded.
