You have raised a number of queries and concerns in your email and I have responded to these below with reference to my other responses where appropriate.

Arrangements for and access to football field

I have responded to your concerns about the status/arrangements of the football field & exchange land and access to the field in my response to your online submission Ref: A55J15J16-079-R.

Use of your garden and land ownership

I have also responded to your enquiry about use of your garden and land ownership in a separate response Ref: A55J15J16-009A-R.

Design of the sound barrier at the bottom of Maes y Llan

I hope you found the site meeting on 6 July regarding the noise barriers useful. We certainly appreciated the input of the residents. We are looking at options for noise mitigation and will be in touch with our revised proposals once completed.

Safety of the new road crossing to the footbridge

I note your concern with respect to the safety for people crossing the road and, in particular, local children and animals when trying to get to the beach. The design of the new at-grade pedestrian crossing will be undertaken in accordance with best practice and design standards, which would provide an at-grade crossing that would allow people of all ages to cross safely. The form and design for the crossing would be finalised at detailed design. It is currently anticipated however, that this would be a toucan crossing to cater for both cyclists and pedestrians.

I hope I have satisfactorily addressed the points you have raised.
